

Dear Volunteer,

Thank you for volunteering with Habitat for Humanity of San Antonio! Your health and safety are important to us, and we want to ensure you have a safe and enjoyable build experience. In addition to the construction safety information you will receive on the build site, we also want you to be aware of the basic protective measures you can take related to the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) outbreak. The World Health Organization (www.who.int) offers the follow guidelines:

1. Stay home if you feel unwell. If you have a fever, cough and difficulty breathing, seek medical attention. Stay informed and follow advice given by your healthcare provider.
2. Wash your hands frequently. Regularly and thoroughly clean your hands with an alcohol-based (60 percent) hand rub or wash them with soap and water. Remember on site we have hand sanitizer as well as hand washing stations.
3. Avoid hugs and handshakes. Use alternate ways of greeting people and maintain at least 3 feet distance between yourself and anyone who is coughing or sneezing.
4. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth. Once contaminated, hands can transfer the virus to your eyes, nose or mouth and can make you sick.
5. Cover your mouth and nose with your bent elbow or tissue when you cough or sneeze. Then dispose of the used tissue immediately.
6. If you have fever, cough and difficulty breathing, seek medical care early.
7. Stay informed on the latest developments about COVID-19. Follow advice given by your healthcare provider, your national and local public health authority or your employer on how to protect yourself and others from COVID-19.

We look forward to seeing you on our build site as we help our first time homebuyers achieve the stability they need to build a better life for themselves and their family. If you feel unwell or decide not to participate, please contact me.
